Light-Curable Adhesives, Sealants and Masks

UV curable adhesive for rapid and high strength bonding of glass and plastics.

VBB is a solvent-free, UV/Visible light curable adhesive that forms resilient, high peel strength bonds between glass, steel, aluminum, stainless steel, and many plastics including acrylic. Product VBB is very low viscosity which permits fast dispensing into pre-formed wells or through capillary action between two substrates. Bonds prepared using VBB are optically clear and highly resistant to moisture and yellowing. This product is suitable for applications that involve environmental thermal cycling. Product VBB is most optimally cured using a full spectrum UV curing lamp, (320-460nm wavelength). This product may also be cured using an LED curing system producing output wavelength of 365nm or 405nm.

PACKAGING OPTIONS - Standard packaging for this product includes 10 and 30 gram syringes, 300 gram cartridges, one kilogram bottles, and 17 kilogram pails. Other packaging options may be available upon request.

STORAGE – This is light sensitive material. Containers must remain covered when not in use. Minimize exposure of uncured material to daylight, artificial light, and UV light during storage and handling. Store uncured product in its original, closed container in a dry location. Unless otherwise indicated on the product label, optimal storage temperatures are 10 to 30°C, (50 to 86°F). Any material removed from the original container must not be returned to the container as it could be contaminated. Panacol-USA cannot assume responsibility for products that were improperly stored, contaminated, or repackaged into other containers.

HANDLING AND CLEAN-UP – For safe handling information, consult this product's **Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS)** prior to use. Uncured material may be wiped away from surfaces with organic solvents. <u>Do not</u> <u>use</u> solvents to remove material from eyes or skin!

USING THE PRODUCT – Prior to dispensing, ensure that each surface coming in contact with this product is clean and free of grease, mold release, or other contaminants. Dispense directly from the package, or utilize appropriate dispensing equipment that is compatible with light-curable adhesives and coatings. Fluid lines and dispense tips must be 100% light blocking. Curing stations should be equipped with air exhaust systems to evacuate vapors and heat generated during the curing process. After curing, this product must be allowed to cool to ambient temperature before testing the product's performance.

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
